#### The Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Our Lady has been called by many beautiful titles, such as the Blessed Mother, the Mother of Lod, the Queen of Heaven. The Saints of every age have tried to find the most perfect names for her. They wanted to show the high place which Lod has given Mary in creation. They wanted to praise the holiness, the beauty and sweetness of the Mother of Lod. Some of the loveliest of these titles have been gathered together in a prayer called the Litany of the Blessed Virgin or the Litany of Loreto.

A Litany is a solemn prayer used by the Church to beg Lod's help. In the Litany of the Blessed Virgin we call Our Lady by her various names, asking her each time to pray to Lod for us. If some of the titles seem strange to us, we must remember that a number of them are symbols or signs. For instance, Our Lady is called in the Litany "Mystical Rose." This means that her love of Lod is very great, for the rose is the token of love. It also means that Mary's goodness and holiness are like the perfume a rose sheds around it.

As we think of the beautiful names in Our Blessed Mother's Litany, our knowledge and love of her will grow.

The Litany may be said when we are praying by ourselves, that is, privately; or when we pray with others, publicly. When it is recited publicly in church, the priest says the first part of each invocation and the people follow with the second part, which is called the response.
