Our Great Exemplar

HOW sublime is the example set by the Redeemer to young people especially! 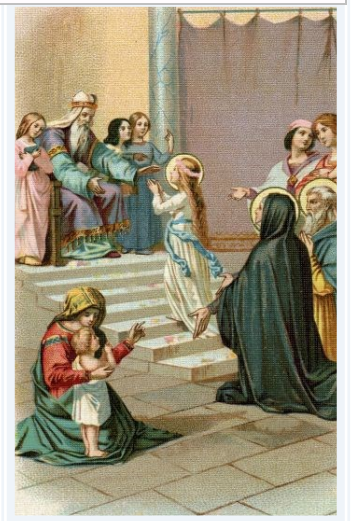

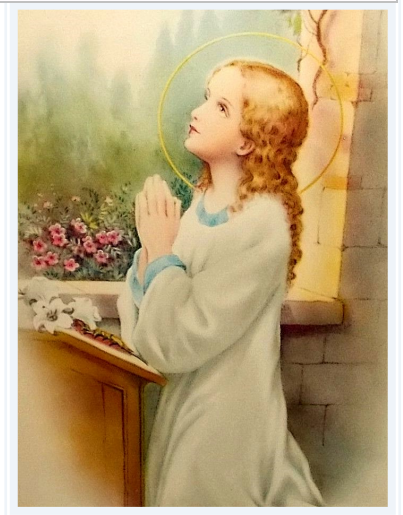

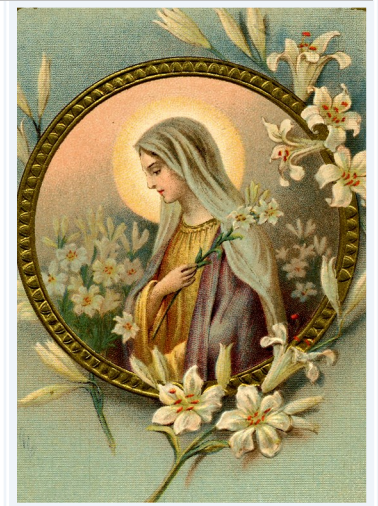
